- 4. Each participant may use only one nickname

5. Procedure

You must put one copy of your Comic, Haiku, Narrative or Poem in a big envelope which will be available at the caretaker's office. Write your category (A Comic Strip / Haiku / Narrative / Poem) on the envelope. Write your name, surnames, class group and nickname on a piece of paper, put it in a small envelope stapled on the big one
